

Disclaimer Data Processing

1. Collection and retention of personal data:

We may collect and process personal data of yourself, your employees or other stakeholders provided by you such as names, e-mail-addresses, phone numbers, professional positions and other non-sensitive personal data.

Your personal data collected by us will be used for business purposes (e.g. contact information, marketing purposes) and kept as long as we deem it necessary.

If you apply for an open position at Autoneum, we will process your application data for the duration of the application procedure.

2. Transfer of personal data to third parties

If necessary, we may transfer personal data within Autoneum or to external Data Processors (art. 28 GDPR). Transferring your personal data to other third parties requires your explicit consent.

3. Your rights

You may withdraw your consent to process your personal data at any time (art. 7 sec. 3 GDPR).

You are entitled to ask for information about your personal data that are processed by us. In particular, you can obtain information about the purposes of the processing, the categories of personal data concerned and the envisaged period for which the data will be stored (art. 15 GDPR).

You may request immediate rectification of inaccurate personal data (art. 16 GDPR).

You may request the erasure of your personal data without undue delay if the personal data are no longer necessary in relation to the purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed, you withdraw your consent on which the processing is based according and where there is no other legal ground for the processing (art. 17 GDPR).

You may request to restrict the processing of your personal data if you contest their accuracy for a period enabling us to verify the accuracy of the personal data. The same applies if you think that the processing is unlawful or we no longer need your personal data (art. 18 GDPR).

You have the right to receive your personal data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format (art. 20 GDPR).

You can lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority (art. 77 GDPR).

4. Right to object

According to art. 21 GDPR, you are entitled to object the processing of such data if your personal data are processed based on legitimate interests according to art. 6 section 1 lit. f GDPR.
